

Admission Policy and Procedure 2020-21

Intent

Al-Islamia Institute for Education is an independent school within the heart of Leicester. We have been established for nearly 15 years and deliver a primary education to children aged between 5 and 11 years old. We are a single-form entry school, with small class sizes and therefore places in each year group are limited.

Choosing your child's school is a consideration that parents take very seriously, and rightly so. We believe that a visit to our school – in person or virtually – can provide parents with vital information about our setting and our approach to nurturing and supporting young people. We welcome visitors, and invite you to contact the School Office to arrange a tour at your convenience.

We have a scheduled Fun Day each summer, open to the public, held on the school grounds. The access to the school space under informal circumstances enables prospective students and families to watch and engage with our staff and school community. This event is published on our calendar on the school website.

Implementation

The school operates a one-form entry, catering to pupils from Years 1 to 6. We do not consider academic achievement or ability when considering admission – our community is made up of a tapestry of various people, and this is reflected within our school. We know that cost can be a factor when considering a suitable school for your children. To alleviate this as much as possible, we offer the lowest fee per annum for an independent, primary setting within Leicester.

At Al-Islamia, we aim to build an environment of excellence – academic and personal – through the implementation of our values. Those who attend here must simply show a willingness and commitment to working with us to uphold and characterise our ethos. The school operates a waiting list, which is arranged in date order of received application. When reviewing applications, we do consider the following:

- Availability within class at time of application
- Children of staff working at the school in any capacity
- Children with siblings attending the school already
- Position on the waiting list
- Residence within the priority area (Leicester City)

Procedure

1. Parents shall complete the application form and return it to the school. Application forms are available from the school or direct from the website
2. The Office Admin shall mark each form with the date received and place it in the waiting list folder within the relevant year group
3. When a space is available, the child and parent/s will be invited to meet with the Curriculum Coordinator and Head Teacher. At this time, children will complete the following age-appropriate assessments to ensure adequate support upon entry:
 - a. SPAG
 - b. Maths

c. Reading

4. A letter of offer will be sent to parents/carers with a start date and fee amount. The fee amount will be calculated from the Start Date to the end of the academic year
5. Parents are required to pay a registration fee of £100.00 to accept an offer of a place for each child
6. A Standing Order mandate must be set up before the first payment of fees is due to ensure a regular payment of fees over the course of the academic year.

Resubmission:

Parents can resubmit their application after:

1. Withdrawing from the list (by refusing a place or by instructing the school in regards to this)
2. Withdrawing a child partway through the academic year.

These applications will be considered as new applications, and the Procedure outlined above will be implemented.

Impact

To ensure that every child has fair access to the Primary setting, we:

- Monitor the characteristics (as best as we can) of children joining the group to ensure that our intake is representative of social diversity.
- Make our equal opportunities policy widely known.

Responsibility

The Management Team, under the guidance of the Governing Body, shall be responsible for allocating places.
