

Communication and Language

Ask your children to imagine they are going on a journey into space. Can they explain what they would want to take with them on their journey and why?

Mathematics

Provide 2D shape templates for children to draw around and decorate to look like aliens. Can they make a square/circle/triangle rocket?

Expressive Arts and Design

Create wax resist space pictures. Provide wax crayons for children to use to draw stars, planets and rockets. Then, paint over the top with watery black/ blue paint.

Personal, Social and Emotional

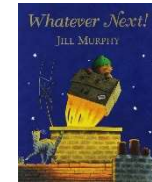
Ask your children to think about what it would feel like to be on a space mission. Have they ever stayed away from home? How did they feel? Was it exciting? What did they do?

Physical

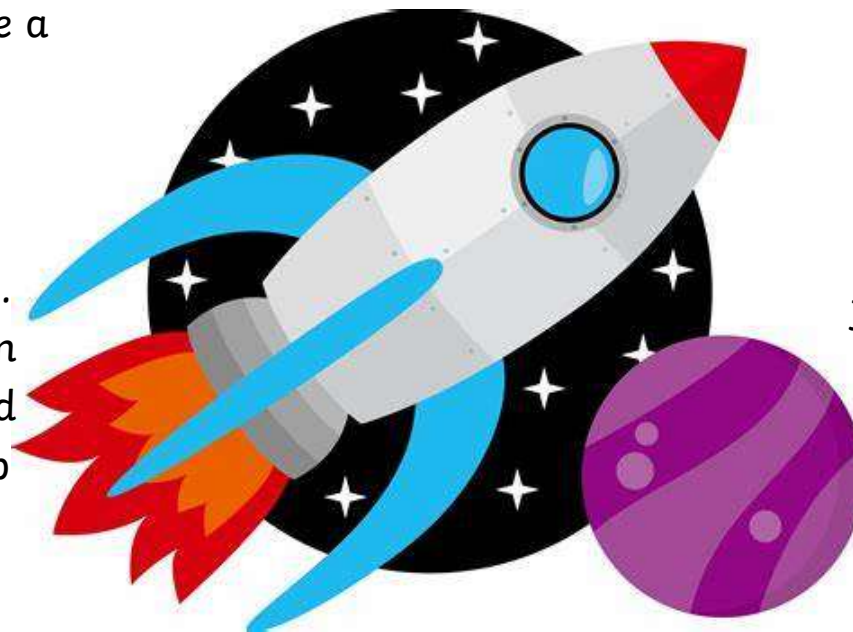
Support your child fine motor development with some leaves cutting.
