

Communication and Language

Experiment with water and use scientific vocabulary to describe what you see. What happens to water if we freeze it? What happens when it melts?

Mathematics

Can your child make comparisons between quantities? Use a range of containers, cylinders, jugs or bottles and fill them with different amounts of water. Can your child tell you which has more, less, which is half full, full, nearly empty or empty?

Expressive Arts and Design

Create a wintery picture using your own self chosen materials.

Personal, Social and Emotional

Discuss with your child how Winter makes them feel. Can they use the words happy, sad, angry worries, upset to describe their feelings?

Physical

Think about some of the clothing we might wear during the season Winter. E.g. hat, scarf, gloves, coat. Can you put these on independently? Can you zip your coat up independently?

Literacy

Practice writing your name. what sound does your name start with?
